Interested bidders and subcontractors are encouraged to attend the conference in order to gain information about the ITB requirements.

An optional second viewing of the work site is scheduled for all potential prime and sub-contractors on July 23, 2024 at 8:30am. No project details will be shared at this meeting.

The work involves a tenant improvement to an existing Servery, a part of the existing Cascade Crest commercial kitchen, and the adjacent Dining Room. The Servery provides food and beverage point of sale and limited food preparation. The work will require finish upgrades including custom cabinetry and coordination of mechanical, electrical, and plumbing. The Contractor will also work with the Owner to coordinate installation of Owner provided furnishings and equipment.
