Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Vancouver, Washington, for ITB 24-01: Electrical Replacement Project bids up to the hour of 11:00am, Pacific Local Time, Tuesday, March 26, 2024 and will publicly open and read aloud at that time on the same day in the Vancouver City Hall, 415 W 6th St, Vancouver, Washington and via an online platform.

This Contract provides for the removal and replacement of the existing Pearson Field Airport’s Runway 8-26 edge lighting system, including associated light fixtures, cable, and conduit. Additional construction items include the replacement of the existing regulator, installation of a backup regulator, installation of a backup generator and other work, all in accordance with the attached Plan Set, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications, hereafter referred to as “Work.”

All work under the contract shall be substantially completed within 40 Working Days of the Notice to Proceed date with all work expected to take place between September 1, 2024 and October 31, 2024. Runway 8-26 shall not be closed for more than 40 Working Days total contained within eight (8) continuous calendar weeks.

An optional pre-bid meeting is to be held at 11:00am, local time on MARCH 12, 2024, at the Airport (101 E Reserve St, Vancouver, WA). Interested prime contractors are encouraged to attend. At this meeting, questions concerning the Contract Documents and the proposed work will be discussed. A tour of the project site will be conducted after the meeting, after which, no other formal tours or site visits will be scheduled.
